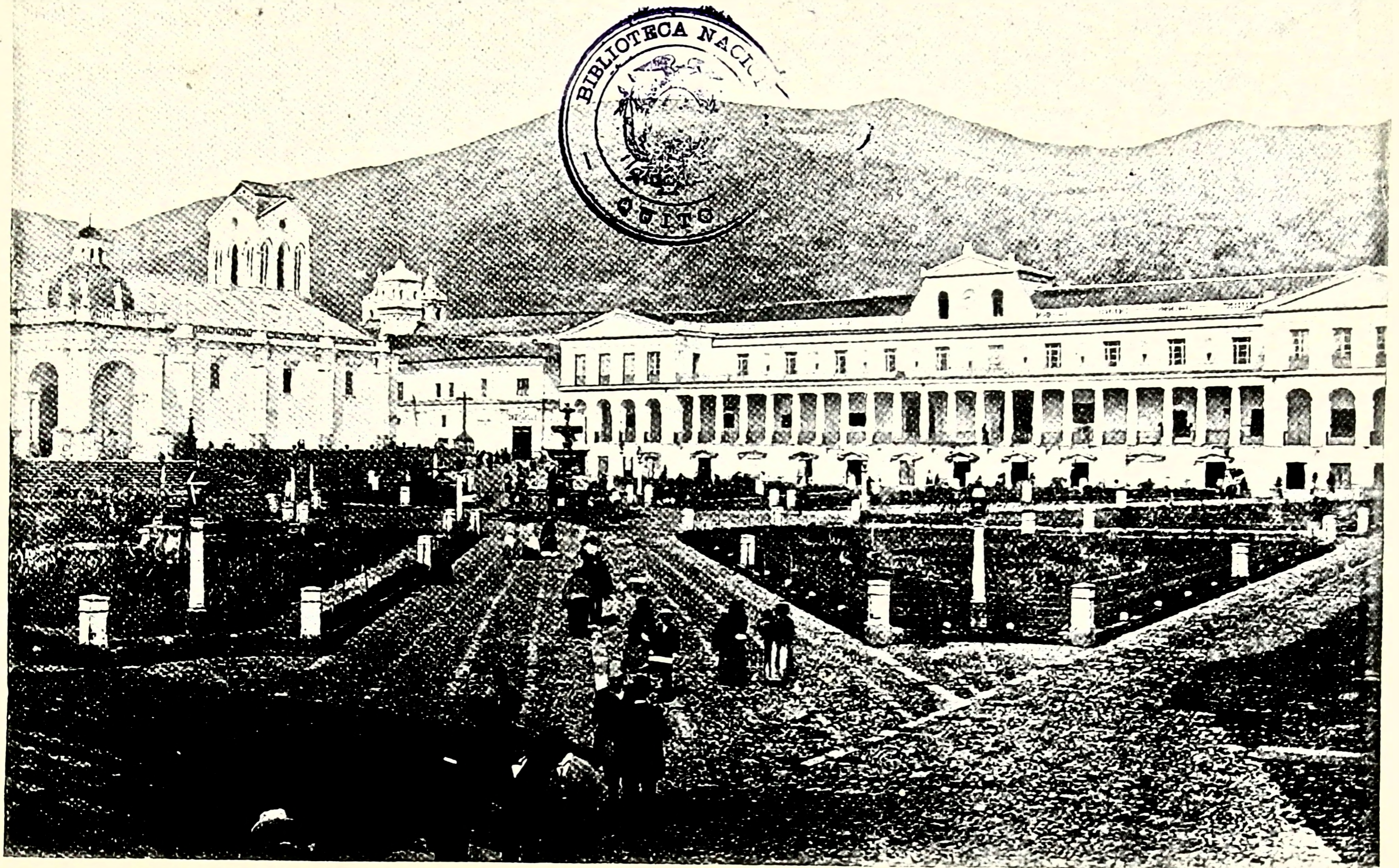

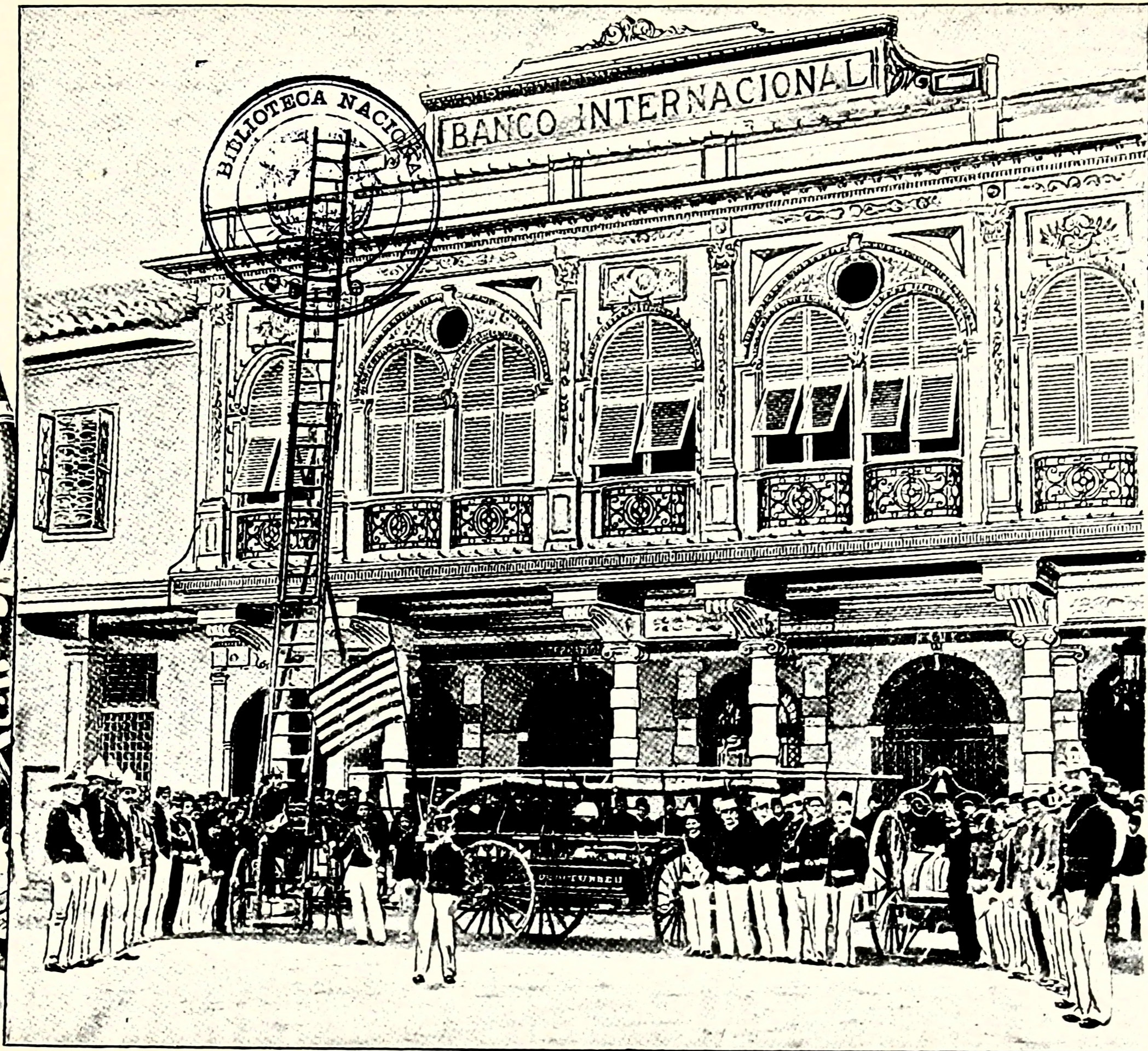

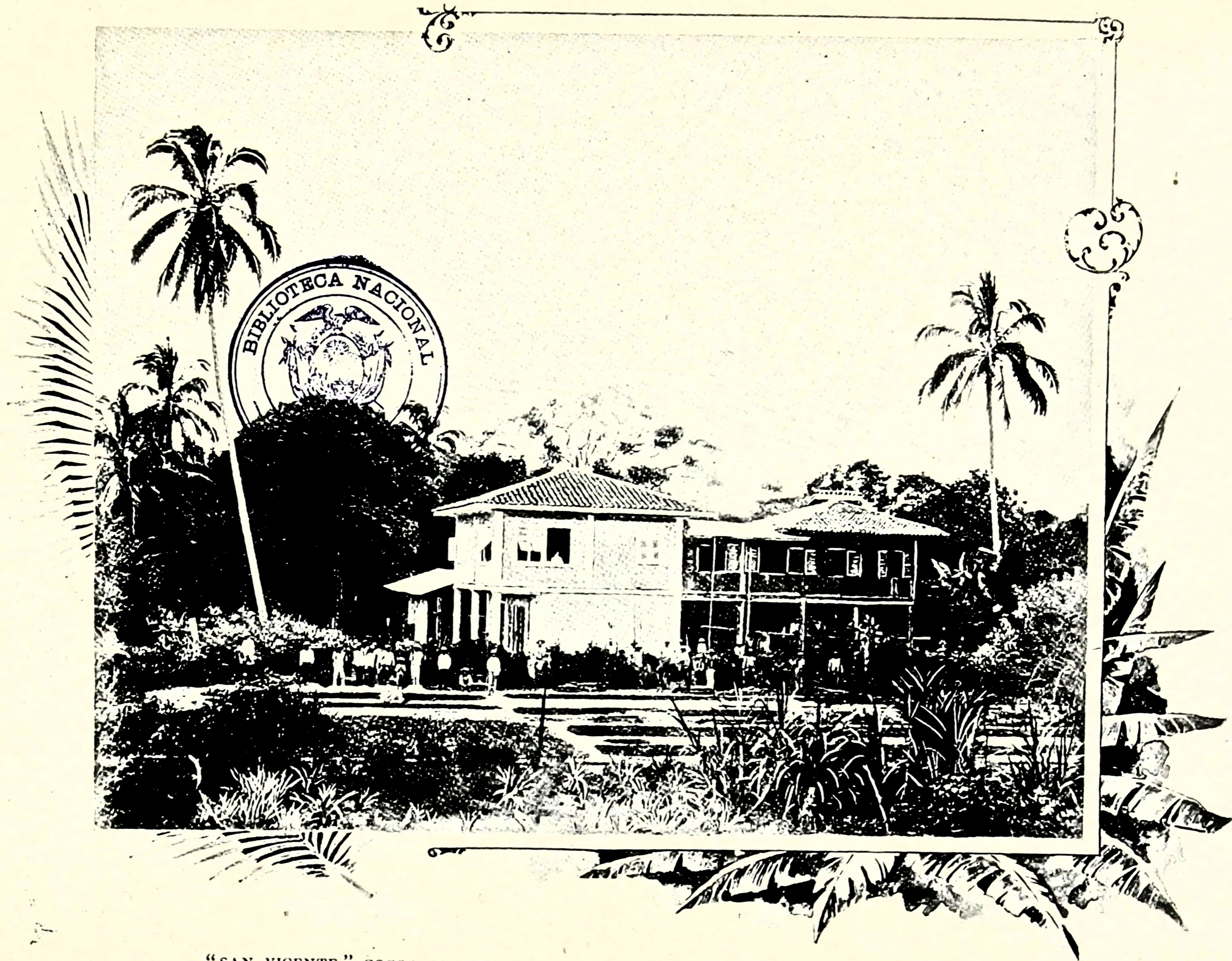
GOVERNMENT PALACE IN QUITO, CAPITAL OF ECUADOR.
